- Speakers:** **Denny Duron** has been an Assemblies of God pastor and evangelist. For twenty years he pastored Shreveport Community Church in Shreveport, Louisiana. As a college quarterback, Denny was a 2-time Division 2 National Champion with Louisiana Tech. In 1976 he was drafted by the Washington Redskins. After leaving the Redskins training camp he accepted an invitation to start the football program at Evangel University in Springfield, MO. Denny later established the football program at Evangel

Christian Academy in Shreveport, with the program gaining national prominence in a few years. Denny is currently featured in the Amazon documentary *God. Family. Football.*

**Jacob Bock** is a long-time Assemblies of God missionary in Spain. Starting out as a kid's evangelist, Jacob would share the Gospel using a unicycle, balloon animals and juggling. Years into his ministry, Jacob was challenged by God's Spirit asking: "What would you have to say if you didn't have any of these props?" This marked a turning point in his ministry. He now leads the ministry "On the Redbox" which works to take the Gospel into the heart of Spain's cities. The "On the Redbox" ministry includes an evangelism training school.
